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

# Roles within the TYPO3 ecosystem

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- Editors
- Integrators
- Developers
- Consultants



## Editors

- Comfortable working the TYPO3 backend
- Create & manage pages and structure them
- They add and arrange content to pages
- Other types of content: Forms, news articles, blog posts
- Don't need to know HTML & CSS

# Integrators

- Install and configure your installation
  - Domain, setup languages
  - Manage system extensions
- Securing your TYPO3 installation
  - Managing updates for the Core and third party extensions
  - Granting appropriate access to backend users (editors)
- Manage your sites look & feel
  - Templating (HTML & CSS) using site packages

# Developers


- Extend your TYPO3 installation by developing custom extensions
  - Integration with another CRM / shop / CMS
  - Custom extension that does something specific for you / customer
- Contribute back to TYPO3 Core
  - Fixing bugs
  - Testing new features
  - Creating new features for TYPO3 Core

## Consultants

- Talk to customers and collaborate with them on projects
- Good understanding of how TYPO3 works (high level)
- Comfortable describing TYPO3 features to clients
- Typically from a project management, consultant or product owner background

# Collaboration Across Roles

More than once, you will find that multiple roles touch on the responsibilities of others – and vice versa. Some overlap in tasks is likely, while others are clearly defined by individual training, skills, and experience.

The TYPO3 CMS Certified Editor manages pages and content with the various page and content element types provided by integrators. The TYPO3 CMS Certified Editor creates new pages, restructures the page tree and manages languages available in the setup.

### A Global Standard for TYPO3 Certifications

The TYPO3 Certification Team is committed to the development of a global standard for TYPO3 certifications. The certification program verifies the knowledge of the certified and the organizations employing them. The exams consist of multiple steps, each requiring different expertise.

A Collaboration between the Certification and the Education Team provides learning materials to support the certification candidates.

### Syllabus

The "TYPO3 CMS Certified Editor" (TCCE) manages pages and content with various page and content element types provided by integrators. The "TYPO3 CMS Certified Editor" creates new pages, restructures the page tree, sets up content properly in the context of TYPO3 and manages the localization of the created pages and content.


